How to Calculate Total Tuition for Customized MIX & MATCH Courses

Aggregate all tuition for each course you intend to register for in order to calculate total amount of tuition for your customized courses.

Example: If you choose to take 2 Course Units (CUs) from the Intensive English Program plus another 2 Course Units (CUs) from the TOEFL Program, your total amount of tuition for a 4-week MIX & MATCH course is:

$$(4\text{-week Tuition for 2 CUs of Intensive English Program}) + (4\text{-week Tuition for 2 CUs of TOEFL Program}) \\ = \$280 + \$300 = \underline{\$580}$$
